# CMLA - Activity Report - 2018

## 1. Representation

The Mediterranean Committee is an independent auxiliary organ of United World Wrestling and follows the regulations that are applied to the continental councils.

The committee brings together all the Mediterranean federations affiliated to the international federation. The Mediterranean Committee of Associated Wrestling Styles "CMLA" was created and established with the approval and under the guidance of the international federation and in compliance with its statutes and rules.

In January 2016, in agreement with the Bureau, at the request of the UWW, the CMLA has established Regional Committee.

The office is the headquarters of the Federation which originated the President of CMLA, CMLA has an attached was created and allowed the transfer of financial funds that was previously attached to those of the UWW.

In November 2016, is held in Madrid, the Ordinary and Extraordinary Meeting to amend the statutes.

In August 2017, during the World Championship was held in Paris the elective General Assembly that renewed the office and its board of directors.

## 2. Aims and Principles
