Sanitary Protocol Beach Wrestling World Series

Saint-Laurent-du-Var – 2021, July 16th – 17th



The health and sanitary plan of wrestling championships that take place under the UWW official calendar is clearly defined by the UWW Medical Regulations.

Following the previous championship that have been organized under special precautionary measures, the organizer has decided to apply a similar sanitary plan to insure the safety of the participants' health and the success of the Beach Wrestling World Series first stop.

We are likely to receive any suggestions or different opinions.

I. Obligations of national teams

All teams must:

- provide a medical examination no later than 7 days before their arrival at the World Series (athletes and staff members). This examination must include all the necessary clinical and laboratory tests performed to eliminate the suspicion of the presence of Covid 19 infection.
 Documents should be submitted immediately upon arrival at the airport or sent earlier by email to FRA@unitedworldwrestling.org
- provide an Honor Pledge declaring that no symptoms that could indicate a COVID619 infection
- provide a negative PCR test on Covid 19 **no older than 72 hours** before their competition day (athletes) or their arrival day (staff). A copy of this test (in english) will be immediately submitted upon arrival at the accreditation center

If for some reasons the testing cannot be done in the home country, please inform the championship management as soon as possible. As long as the results will not be received, the wrestlers or staff will NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE COMPETITION.

- provide a sufficient amount of protective masks for each member. Wearing a mask is mandatory for all participants in the Ranking except during training and fights.

In case of any problems with participants that may raise the suspicion of Covid 19 infection, the team leader will immediately report to the Organizer for examination by an infectologist.

II. Transportation of participants

Transportation of participants from an to the airport will be done by special buses. They will be disinfected twice a day, the first time after taking the competitors to the accreditation center, and the second time after the end of daily obligations.

Only accredited participants of the championship can enter the means of transport by wearing appropriate masks.

III. Accreditations

As usual, the accreditations will be given at the accreditation center, according to the established schedule. Hand sanitizers will be provided, as well as adequate toilet space. The organizer will try to have only one national team present during the accreditation process.

IV. Hotel accommodation and catering

All participants will be accommodated in appropriate hotel rooms supplied with a sufficient amount of hygiene and disinfection equipment.

There will be hand sanitizers at the entrance to the restaurant. The dining tables will be arranged so that there is the necessary distance between the guests

V. Training process

The training process will take place at the competition site. Only wrestlers will be authorized to enter the . Before entering the ring, the organizer will be sure to pass the appropriate disinfection barrier for hands. It will be placed at the entrance to the training room.

VI. Medical examination of competitors before measurement

The medical examination of the competitors before the measurement is performed by certain doctors separately for each category that is planned for the fights on that day. In addition to the examination prescribed by the UWW regulations, body temperature is also measured.

VII. Medical care

Medical care is performed according to the UWW Medical Regulations. One doctor and one medical technician will be present at each wrestling mat. During the competition, each team will have the medical equipment to provide the necessary assistance. Each medical worker will also have an appropriate protective mask, and when providing the necessary help to the competitors, they will have special gloves that are disposed of after use.

The medical team will be located next to the field with all the necessary equipment for medical assistance as well as the means for transporting the injured competitors to the appropriate medical institution.

A doctor and a medical technician will be present in the ambulance located within the competition facility, who will provide the necessary medical assistance to other participants in the competition.

The special outpatient clinic for examinations where the infectious disease specialist will stay will be located separately from the other rooms and will be specially marked. It will be used for examination of participants with suspected infectious symptoms. If necessary, samples will be taken for appropriate analyzes in order to verify the nature of the problem or to decide on referral to other competent infectious disease institutions.

In front of the competition hall, 2 ambulances of the resuscitation vehicle type will be parked, which will transport the injured to the appropriate medical institutions if necessary.

VIII. Hygiene of the wrestling rings

All competitors will proceed to the disinfection barrier for hand disinfection.

IX. Anti-doping control

Eventual anti-doping control will take place according to clear WADA rules, except that different rooms will be added to the existing ones in order to avoid a larger number of competitors for anti-doping control in a small space.

X. Behavior of participants during the competition

It is necessary to adhere to basic preventive medical measures such as social distance, wearing clean masks and hand disinfection. Contact between participants in the competition should be reduced to avoiding contacts, except those necessary in the competition program, with other participants in the competition from other teams.

XI. Control PCR test on Covid 19

The obligation of the organizers is that all participants in the organization of the competition who are in contact with competitors or other members of the National teams have a negative PCR test on Covid 19, which at the beginning of the competition is not older than three days.

The organizer will provide PCR test before departure to the delegations that will request it. The cost of this test is set at 85€ and will be invoiced to the delegations.
