

REPORT OF AN ANTI-DOPING RULE VIOLATION

In accordance with Article 14.3 of the United World Wrestling Anti-Doping Rules ("UWW ADR"), the UWW hereby reports that the Athlete <u>Mr Angus Patrick ARTHUR</u> (JAM) has committed an Anti-Doping Rule Violation under Article 2.1 of the UWW ADR - Presence of a Prohibited Substance or its Metabolites or Markers in an Athlete's Sample.

More precisely, a sample collected from the Athlete on 8 March 2020 during the Senior Pan-American Championships has revealed the Presence of the metabolite of the Prohibited Substance *dehydrochloromethyltestosterone*. *Dehydrochloromethyl-testosterone* is listed under S1.1 (Exogenous Anabolic Androgenic Steroids) of the 2020 WADA prohibited list and is prohibited at all times.

The Athlete has been sanctioned as follows:

- 1. Mr Angus Patrick ARTHUR has committed a violation of Article 2.1 of the UWW ADR.
- 2. Mr Angus Patrick ARTHUR is suspended for a period of Ineligibility of 4 years.
- 3. The period of Ineligibility starts on 18 June 2020 and shall remain in full force and effect until 17 June 2024.
- 4. In accordance with Articles 9 and 10.10 of the UWW ADR, all the competitive results obtained by Mr Angus Patrick ARTHUR from 8 March 2020 until 18 June 2020 are disqualified with all the resulting consequences, including forfeiture of any medals, points and prizes.
