




## Samples collected by UWW (in & out-of-competition)

## Minimum Levels of Analysis (MLAs) for ESA & Growth Hormones

WADA's requirements for Wrestling:

Erythropoiesis Stimulating Agents (ESAs) 15% Growth Hormone/Growth Hormone Releasing Factors 10%

## Total Adverse Analytical Findings (AAFs) in 2016

Total: 135 (AAFs)

- Total figures for the sport of Wrestling in all styles, worldwide
- Out of 135 AAFs: 62 AAFs for Meldonium (73 for other substances)
- AAFs detected on:
  - National level wrestlers
  - International level wrestlers
  - Olympic disciplines
  - Other styles (Pankration, Grappling and traditional wrestling)
- + 3 Anti-doping Rules Violations for Refusing Sample Collection












## Substances detected in 2016 (without Meldonium)

## Total AAFs for UWW tests (UWW Testing Authority - TA)


49 Adverse Analytical Findings

#### Breakdown:

- 34 cases of Meldonium
- 15 cases of other substances:
  - 7 AAFs for Diuretics & Masking Agents
  - 7 AAFs for Anabolic agents (Stanozolol, Boldenone, Ostarine, Testosterone, Nandrolone, Metendienone)
  - 1 AAF for Stimulants (Amphetamine)

### Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUEs)

- 2016: 15 applications
- →8 approved (Prednisone, betamethasone, cortisone, spironolactone, fenoterol)
- →7 denied (amphetamine, methylphenidate, dexamethasone, stanozolol)
- + 3 recognized (granted by a NADO and recognized by UWW)
- + 13 applications for authorized medications (no TUE needed)

TUE Procedure: Retroactive TUEs for urgency treatment



# Athlete Passport Management Unit (APMU)

- UWW collaborates with the WADA accredited laboratory of Paris for the review of all steroid passports in Wrestling
- Recommendations are made by the laboratory with regard to atypical steroid passports:
  - further analysis by the lab needed;
  - other tests required to complete a passport;
  - Request to labs to verify the data submitted in ADAMS
  - Long-term storage of samples
- In 2016, the APMU reviewed the data of each steroid profiles (1739 data in total), which corresponds to 946 steroid passports
