



REPORT OF AN ANTI-DOPING RULE VIOLATION

In accordance with Article 14.3 of the United World Wrestling Anti-Doping Rules (“UWW ADR”), the UWW hereby reports that **Mr Haithem Dakhlaoui** (TUN) (the “Athlete”) has committed an Anti-Doping Rule Violation under Article 2.1 of the UWW ADR - Presence of a Prohibited Substance or its Metabolites or Markers in an Athlete’s Sample.

More precisely, a sample collected from the Athlete on 25 January 2022 during an Out-of-Competition anti-doping control revealed the Presence of the Prohibited Substance *testosterone*. *Testosterone* is listed under S1. Anabolic Androgenic Steroids of the 2022 WADA Prohibited Lists and is prohibited at all times.

The Athlete has been sanctioned as follows:

1. Mr Haithem DAKHLAOUI has committed a violation of Article 2.1 of the UWW ADR.
2. Mr Haithem DAKHLAOUI is suspended for a period of Ineligibility of **3 years**.
3. The period of Ineligibility starts on 28 April 2022, and shall remain in full force and effect until 27 April 2025.
4. In accordance with Article 10.10 of the UWW ADR, all the competitive results obtained by Mr Haithem Dakhlaoui from 25 January 2022 until 28 April 2022 are disqualified with all the resulting consequences, including forfeiture of any medals, points and prizes.
