# ABOUT THE CITY

Bishkek is the capital of Kyrgyzstan and the country's largest population of over 1 million. The capital of Kyrgyzstan, Bishkek, is the borderline of Central Asia's Tian Shan range. The Kyrgyz Ala-Too mountains and Ala-Archa National Park, adorned with wildlife trails and glaciers, conclude the place's scenic beauty. Bishkek is the country's modern cultural, political, and economic center. It is a quiet city with wide streets and beautiful houses with a distinctive, measured rhythm of life.

Bishkek was founded in 1825 on the ruins of the ancient Pishpek hill fort and the Kokand fortress of Pishpek, which were county trade towns on the caravan route from the 7th to the 13th centuries. The caravans of the Great Silk Road also passed through Bishkek. The rapid development of the city began after 1917. In 1926, Pishpek was renamed Frunze in honor of the revolutionary and statesman. Then it was renamed Bishkek after the fall of the USSR and the gaining independence of the Kyrgyz Republic.



Filled with exotic foliage and historic post-Soviet anachronisms, Bishkek is a city engraved with cultural nuances. The vibrant and youthful atmosphere of the place is why the town witnesses a massive tourist turnout every year. The pulsating nightlife of Kyrgyzstan's capital city is unparalleled. The way to one's heart is through the stomach. If that's the case, the city's food scene will ring a bell.

Be it the mouthwatering Oromo or the tasteful Besh Barmak. One is served a myriad of food choices.





## Climate

Bishkek has a Mediterranean-influenced humid continental climate, with hot, dry, and low cloudy summers and frosty, snowy, and occasionally cloudy winters.

In September, temperatures in Bishkek range from 24,7°C (76,46 °F) to +13°C (55,4°F). In September 2022, the lowest average daily temperature was +16°C (60,8°F), while the highest average temperature reached +33°C (91,4°F). The amount of rain that falls in Bishkek during September is 20.1 mm.

In such a way, September is also a conventionally velveted season in Kyrgyzstan, one of the year's warm months. Windbreakers, light tracksuits or jeans, and t-shirts are appropriate for this time of year in Bishkek.





# VENUE

Competitions will be held at Kojomkul Sports Palace according to their appointed dates.

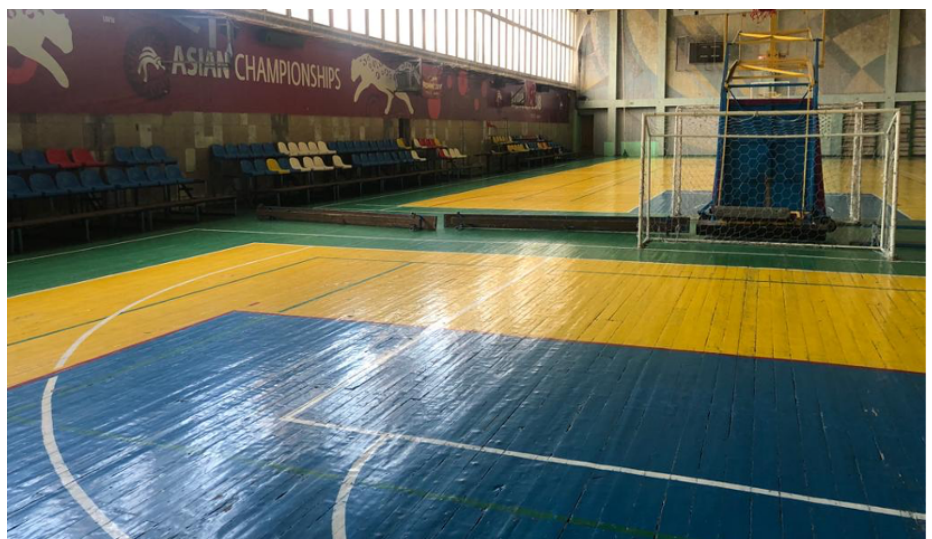


Inside view of the competition venue

**Note:** Athletes can come to this place and conduct training before the competitions. All the necessary equipment will be on-site.



## REFEREE(S)

Each participating country brings at least one UWW licensed referee if they bring more than three (3) wrestlers.

Each participating country is responsible for the costs of meals, accommodation, and local transportation for the UWW licensed referees to reduce the burden on the host's finances.

Suppose the participating country does not bring their country's UWW licensed referee(s). In that case, the host has the right to charge the cost of meals, accommodation, and local transportation for the UWW licensed referees when the participating country arrives at the airport/hotel. The fee is **\$1,200.00 (\$120.00 USD x 10 days)**.

## LICENSE & INSURANCE

All athletes taking part in the competition must have a valid UWW license of the current year, which will also provide insurance in case of an accident. If an athlete does not have a UWW license, it is the respective ICSD Member Nation's responsibility to insure the wrestler, as UWW will not bear any kind of responsibility whatsoever in case of an accident.

## Medical Service at the Competition Venue

At least one heavily equipped ambulance will be staged at the competition venue to facilitate the transfer. In the championships, medical teams consisting of experienced physicians and paramedics will be positioned at designated spots on the Field of Play to act as first responders to injuries or emergencies during the competition or official training sessions.

## COVID-19 Regulations

The Republican Anti-Coronavirus Headquarters reminded that a PCR test for COVID-19 **is not required** when entering or leaving Kyrgyzstan. The relevant order came into force on 1 May 2022. According to it, Kyrgyz citizens and foreigners can cross the state border to Kyrgyzstan without presenting a negative PCR test and a vaccination certificate against COVID-19.

**But!** The PCR test certificate may be required by the country you plan to travel to. It is, therefore, essential to familiarize yourself with foreign countries' entry/exit regulations. If a PCR test is required, we can help you make a PCR test for **\$35 (USD)**. The result you will get after 3-4 hours.

The fees include accommodation, 3x meals (buffet), and transportation to the location: Airport-Hotel-Airport. The OC will provide official transportation and accreditation to those booking through the OC. The rates per night include breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

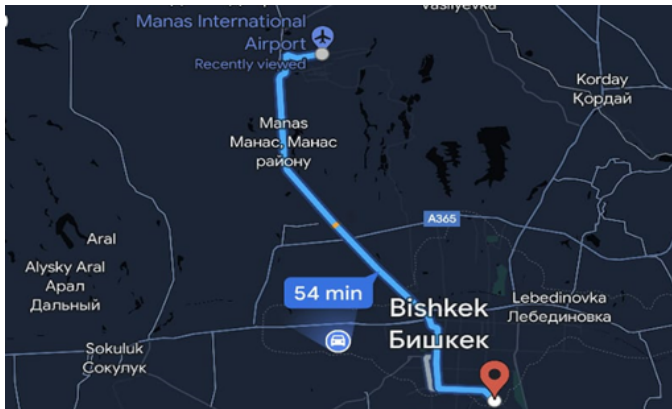

# TRANSPORTATION & MAP

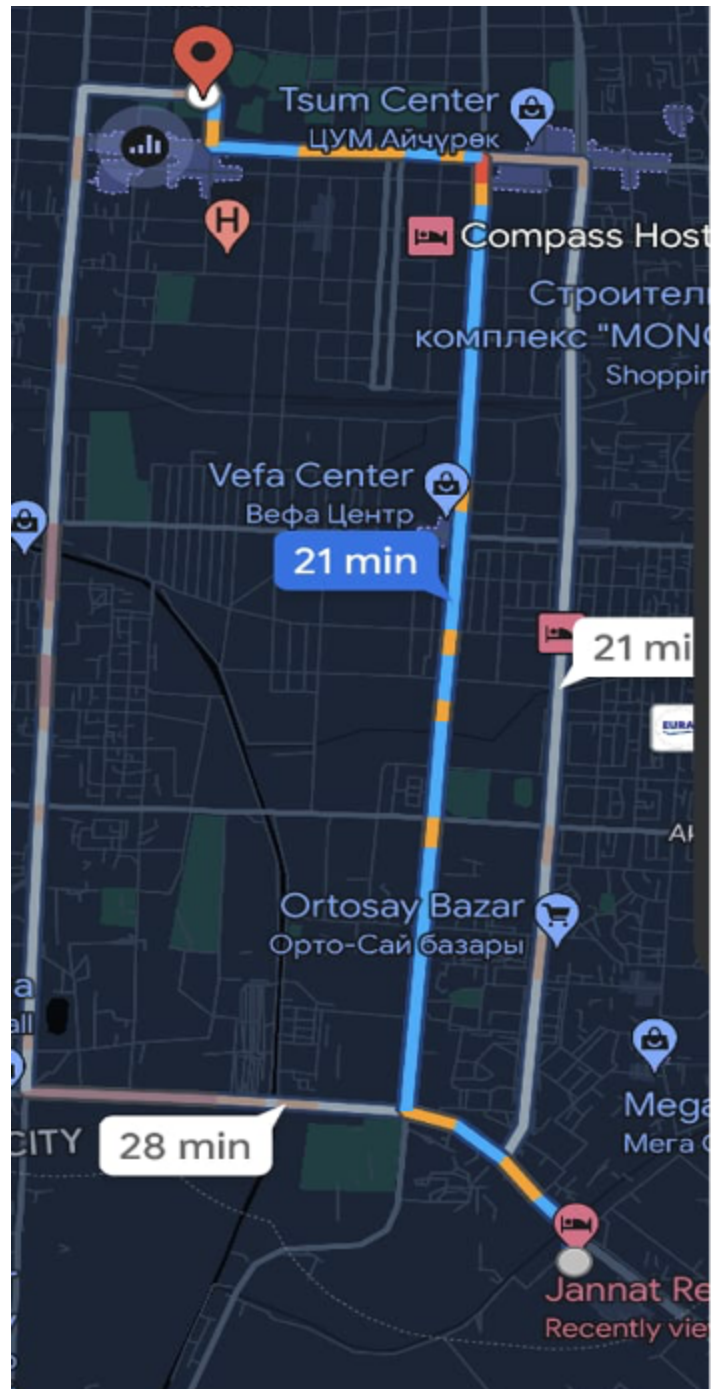
The OC will provide free transportation service from the Manas International Airport to the hotel (and vice versa) for those who make their hotel reservation through the OC.



That is the distance between the hotel and the competition/training venue. It is approximately 8,2 km and 15-20 minutes of drive.

Airport Transfer Service will be available from 02 September to 12 September 2023. Manas International Airport is 37 km away and within a 20 – 30-minute drive. The OC will welcome and accompany participants at the airport throughout their entire ride.

Please note that any changes in departure details must be submitted to the OC at the venue 48 hours before the flight departure.





# VISA

While some Asian countries may be exempt from visas due to the existing agreements concluded between our countries, others can obtain an e-Visa.

Each member of every delegation will be responsible for verifying if he needs a visa to enter the Kyrgyz Republic. It is highly recommended that foreigners, who wish to visit the Kyrgyz Republic, should read the related information about our country's visa regime.

The participants are responsible for requesting the visa, and the OC cannot be liable if the visa is not obtained. The OC can send the participants an invitation letter if necessary.

## LOCAL CURRENCY

The local currency is the Kyrgyz Som. Established credit cards like VISA, MasterCard, American Express, and Union Pay are widely accepted in hotels, restaurants, shops, gas stations, etc.

Due to the unstable currency market in Kyrgyzstan, bringing your own money in cash is highly recommended, as you can face the problem of cashing out the dollars from the card.

## INFORMATION

### Deadline for the applications

- The deadline for the **preliminary registration entry** of the participants is 02 May 2023.
- The final deadline for **registration and hotel reservations** is 02 August 2023.

### Official Participation (OP) Fees

**OC Participation Fee:** \$60 (USD) per person for the organising committee (per athlete and official).

*OP Participation fees include the following:*

- Accreditation Card: Each participant will receive accreditation with a photo. This accreditation allows free entry to all competitions. We ask all to send photos via ICSD OMS for accreditation to keep time.
- Shuttle Service between the official hotel and the sports hall.

Please note that only those who will book through the OC shall be allowed to enter the competitions.

### International Committee of Sports for the Deaf (ICSD) Fees

**ICSD Participation Fee:** \$40 (USD) per person (per athlete and official). The fee must send to ICSD Bank by wire.
