

#### **GENERAL REGULATIONS**

#### **PARTICIPATION:**

- 1. Only the National Federations affiliated or associated to United World Wrestling can participate in the Championship. They are fully responsible for entering their athletes within the deadline.
- National Federations may enter a maximum of 2 athletes per weight category. Final entries confirming the names of participants, number of nights of their staying for the accommodation package should be entered on Athena (<a href="http://athena.uww.org/">http://athena.uww.org/</a>) before 01 May 2024. If you have any issue using Athena, you may contact <a href="mailto:aso@uww.org">aso@uww.org</a> for support.
- 3. The organizing committee is providing an accommodation package that includes accommodation, breakfast, lunch, dinner and transportation. Cost of the accommodation package is 130 CHF/day per person and is to be paid via bank transfer (or during accreditation for necessary countries).

  Note: the minimum stay for the accommodation package is 2 nights.

#### **TECHNICAL CONDITIONS**

- 1. The competition will run according to the official United World Wrestling Pankration rules on 3 mats. (Rules: https://uww.org/governance/regulations-pankration)
- 2. Competitions will be held in the following weight categories:

Pankration Traditional / Pankration Elite - Seniors, U20

- Men: 57, 62, 66, 71, 77, 84, 92, 100, +100kg
- Women: 50, 53, 57, 61, 65, 70, 75, 80, +80kg

Pankration Traditional - U17

- Boys: 42, 46, 50, 54, 58, 63, 69, 76, 85, 92, 110kg
- Girls: 38, 40, 43, 46, 49, 52, 56, 60, 65, 90kg

Age and nationality will be checked at the weight in during passport control.

- 3. Each competitor will be requested to undergo a medical examination before the official weigh-in, during which his/her competition uniforms will be inspected for compliance to United World Wrestling rules.
- 4. All Athletes and Referees are required to have the United World Wrestling License for the competition year 2024 (100 Swiss Francs/Euros for Seniors & U20 / 50 Swiss Francs/Euros for U17) that includes health insurance. Licenses must be purchased online by each National Federation through Athena (<a href="http://athena.uww.org/">http://athena.uww.org/</a>). To purchase a license online, it is required to submit a medical certificate, a copy of the passport and a digital photo of the athlete.
