Calendar 2027-2028-2029 and Bureau decisions

Dear President, dear Secretary General,

This circular aims to inform you of the decisions taken by the Bureau during its last meeting. It concerns the calendars for the upcoming years.

The 2027, 2028 and 2029 calendars' structure were approved and will be published on the UWW website soon. The "Road to Los Angeles 2028" is also confirmed and each National Federation will be able to start planning their preparation.

Please find attached the document "Road to LA28" which provides an overview of the events included in the qualification system for the next Olympic Games.

As previously communicated, the Ranking Series are now part of the Olympic qualification process. The Bureau confirmed that these events must be hosted across different continents. Consequently, a new bidding process will be opened and a separate circular will be sent to you with further details.

The 2028 and 2029 Calendars will be adjusted based on the latest Bureau decisions. First of all, it was decided to switch the organization of the U17 and U20 Continental and World Championships. As the current U17 Continental Championships are organized too early (still during the schoolyear), it was agreed to host the U20 Continental Championships before the U17. The U17 Continental championships will be therefore organised later in the year (summer time).

Another effect to that change will also bring the U20 World Championships earlier in the calendar. It will be organized before the U17 World Championships.

The Technical Commission proposed scheduling the U23 World Championships before the Senior World Championships. The Senior World Championships is the pinnacle event of the year and should be therefore organized the last. Th is proposal was therefore approved.

We hope that this information will assist you in planning for the coming years and we already hope that many of you will express interest in hosting one of these major events.
