PRELIMINARY SCHEDULE OF TRAINING CAMPS FOR 2026

*within the framework of the phased launch and international positioning

Development Partnership Vector: United World Wrestling (UWW)

This document defines the 2026 training camp schedule, the stages of the Center's launch, operating parameters, areas of international cooperation, and the scaling strategy from 2027 onward.

2026

1. General Concept

This document has been developed within the framework of the phased launch of the Kazakhstan Wrestling Academy as a modern international training center for athlete preparation, aimed at integration into the global wrestling development system under the auspices of United World Wrestling (UWW).

The 2026 training camp schedule provides for the sequential implementation of two key stages: the national testing stage and the stage of international integration. This approach ensures a smooth transition from the Center's internal operation to its full-scale functioning as an international training platform.

Stage 1 - May - August 2026

- domestic national training camps
- infrastructure testing
- refinement of organizational and training processes

Stage 2 - September - December 2026

- international training camps
- hosting foreign teams
- integration into the UWW development system

2. Stage 1 - National Training Camps (Testing Stage)

Period: May - August 2026 **Participants: National teams of the Republic of Kazakhstan**

Main objectives:

- testing of the Center's logistical and organizational infrastructure
- refinement of coordination among administrative, coaching, and medical staff
- improvement of the quality of services provided
- optimization of training methodologies
- preparation of the Center for receiving international delegations

3. Stage 2 - International Training Camps (Within the Framework of Cooperation with UWW)

Period: September - December 2026

Participants:

- national federations - members of UWW
- athletes participating in UWW development and scholarship programs
- national teams of the Republic of Kazakhstan

Main objectives:

- integration of the Center into the UWW development system
- development of international cooperation
- organization of joint training processes
- enhancement of athletic performance standards

Expansion outlook from 2027	up to 200 athletes and up to 30 coaches and specialists simultaneously

Services provided:

1	accommodation (full board)
2	access to modern training halls and equipment
3	coaching support
4	basic medical support and recovery procedures
5	organizational and logistical support
6	local transfer (if necessary)

5. Flexibility and Adaptability of the Schedule

The training camp schedule may be adjusted taking into account:

- the UWW international competition calendar
- applications and needs of national federations
- strategic priorities of UWW development programs

6. Additional Areas of Activity

Within the framework of the Center's operation, the implementation of additional programs is envisaged:

- advanced training courses for coaches
- educational seminars for referees
- scientific and methodological support for the training process
- experience exchange programs among national federations

7. Development Strategy of the Center (From 2027)

In order to scale up and strengthen the international role of the Kazakhstan Wrestling Academy, a substantial expansion of the Center's capacities is planned starting from 2027.

The priority of the next stage will be the transition from launch and pilot operation to sustainable international functioning through infrastructure expansion, increased capacity, and strengthened program content.
